

ROLES AND STRUCTURE IN THE TRE® GLOBAL CERTIFICATION TRAINING PROGRAM (GCTP)

TST (Trainer Support Team)

- Develops policy and ongoing collaboration with Certification Trainers (CT) in the development of the TRE® program.
- Provides support, guidance and supervision of CT and Certification Trainer training process.
- Dr. David Berceli certifies CT Trainers on the recommendation of TST members.

CT (Certification Trainer)

- Provides oversight, development, guidance and implementation of the GCTP.
- Oversees the cooperation between Mentors, Mentor Trainees, CT Trainees, Advanced Providers and Providers and Trainees in a particular program.
- Accountable for the quality of the program.
- Ongoing collaboration within the country or region.
- Provide developmental opportunities for CT Trainees, Mentors, Mentor Trainees, Advanced Providers and Providers.
- Provides supervision and oversight to Mentors, Mentor Trainees, Advanced Providers, Providers and Trainees.
- Certifies Trainees.

CT TRAINEE

- Invited by TST (recommended by CT's)
- Under supervision by a TST member with a Learning Plan to develop required competencies as a CT Trainer.
- The time taken will depend on the progress of each individual to meet competencies.

MENTOR

- Mentors will not necessarily and automatically become a CT Trainee.
- Assists on Trainings.
- Provides supervision of Trainees, Providers and personal sessions.
- In collaboration with CT and CT Trainee maintains quality of GCTP.
- Be actively engaged in TRE® by providing workshops, materials, assisting and participating in the development of TRE® nationally.

MENTOR TRAINEE

- Invited by CT – selected from the Advanced Provider category.
- Under supervision by the CT with a learning plan to develop required competencies as a Mentor.
- The time taken to meet the required competencies of the Mentor role will depend on the progress of each individual. Minimum of 12 months.

ADVANCED PROVIDER

- Must be a Certified Provider for at least 2 years.
- Must be a paid up member of TRE® for AFRICA Foundation.
- Must submit application annually and meet the required criteria.
- Once approved can market themselves as Advanced Provider.

PROVIDER

- Completed and certified in GCTP (Global Certification Training Program).
- Completed and certified in Level 1 and Level 2 Practitioner Training (old system).

L1 PRACTITIONER

- Completed and certified in Level 1 only (old system).
- Certified to work with individuals only.
- Not certified to work with hands on interventions.

TRAINEE

- Currently in training in GCTP (Global Certification Program)
